

Instructions to reach The Crossing

The Crossing turnoff is at 392 Nutleys Ck Rd , 3.92 km on dirt section of Nutleys Ck road west of Bermagui, on the south side of Bermagui River (12 mins from town)

Turn into the first street on the southern or main town side of the Bermagui Bridge called Bridge St, past Bridge Motors petrol station & boat ramp. Turn right (west) at crossroads at top of hill (this is Murrah St which becomes Nutleys Ck Rd when the road turns to dirt).

After passing Black Marlin and River Roads take the third turn to the right (north west), signposted "The Crossing". Follow "The Crossing" signs for 2km until you come out of the bush through a paddock, The Crossing is at the end of the dirt track on the Bermagui River.

What to bring to the Crossing

Wear the following for around the centre:

a sunhat (sunglasses are optional)

light-weight long-sleeved shirt with collar & light-weight long pants (to protect against bites, stings and sun)

a pair of sealed shoes, preferably boots or sturdy sneakers, as feet need to be protected in the bush.

Other gear:

acoustic musical instrument

warm sleeping bag and beanie for cold nights

pyjamas and toiletries eg tooth and hair brush and towel

spare underwear, socks, pants and shirt

a small torch

personal first aid (eg: bandaids, triangular bandage, small roll bandage.) also sunscreen

an old pair of sealed shoes that can get soaked for swimming in the salt river area designated by staff (eg:old sandshoes or wetsuit booties as these will give you some protection from the sharp things that may be in estuaries such as oyster shells, stingrays etc)

*The Crossing can supply rain jackets if needed. **Accommodation is in a renovated train carriage bunkhouse. Indoor water is from rainwater tanks.***

When the sun is not shining, the wood stove fire is lit to obtain hot water.
